What Can We Do To Prepare Ourselves?

Sometimes I think that I sound like a broken record. Repeating myself over and over again the dire warning of the coming worldwide economic meltdown. If you seriously take a good look around and read the newspaper or watch the news on TV, you will see the storm clouds gathering. From a biblical perspective it is imperative that people get prepared for what I can see coming on the horizon. We are steamrolling towards the edge of an economic cliff, and most people in our society are totally oblivious to what is going on. So, they are not doing anything to get ready for the immense economic pain that is coming. We have to get prepared physically, financially, mentally, emotionally and spiritually for the great storm that is rapidly approaching.

As I have previously discussed in the last chapter – there are many financial dangers – many financial landmines ready to blow up and we need to protect ourselves. Let me make it clear to you; the next great economic tidal waves that will hit the nations are going to be much more painful than the last one in 2008. None of the problems that caused the last financial crisis have been fixed; they've only thrown money at it and kicked the can further down the road. Fortunately, for the most part we in Canada did not feel too much pain as our economy has been relatively stable over the last number of years and that is a good thing. Except, it has lulled many Canadians into a false sense of security and complacency. Whereas, in other parts of the world they have really suffered especially in Europe, South America and to a certain extent the US. We are in a time of deep political corruption, accelerating social decay with rioting and terrorist attacks in many centres of the world along with great natural disasters.

The vast majority of people are going to be absolutely blindsided by what is coming. They don't understand how our financial system works,

they don't understand how vulnerable it is, and most of them blindly trust that our leaders know exactly what they are doing and that they will be able to fix our problems. As a result, most are simply not prepared for the massive storm that is heading our way. Right now we seem to be living in a "hope bubble" and people have become very complacent. As I pointed out in my previous chapter, our entire financial system is a giant Ponzi scheme. Those that have not made any preparations for what is coming are going to regret it bitterly. It is a fact that we are living in the greatest debt bubble in the history of the world.

It also brings great sadness to my heart seeing that many churchgoers understand very little if anything about the end times. They should if they read the Bible for what it says but they don't; relying instead on what is preached in the pulpit. They're going to be totally unprepared and devastated by what's coming. Sad thing is that many church leaders and ministers don't know what's coming and can't warn their parishioners because they themselves have not been taught about the Rapture, Tribulation, the Millennium and Christ's reign on earth or anything about the end time events preceding the Second Coming of Christ. That is why there is this deafening silence coming from most of the mainline churches. Why is that? Simply, these ministers and pastors were taught in seminary the erroneous teachings of Amillennialism that came about 200 to 300 years after the deaths of the apostles and were not the teachings of the apostles or of Christ Jesus. Through the workings of God's adversary Satan; counterfeit Christianity (false teachings) slowly crept into the early church.

Let me explain: The doctrine of **Amillennialism** denies that there will be a literal kingdom over which Jesus Christ will rule on earth for 1000 years. It teaches that the 1000 years mentioned 6 times in Revelation 20 is a symbolic number. Amillennialists believe that the 1000 years began with the church, and Christ's reign on earth is spiritual in nature. This doctrine is contrary to what Jesus taught and what the apostles believed (Acts 1:6-7). After hundreds of years and Jesus Christ not returning to earth, a few of the early church fathers of the first and second centuries started to believe that maybe there was no literal Millennial kingdom but none of their writings are in existence. Still, only a handful of the early church fathers rejected a literal kingdom. It was not until Augustine (354-430 AD), a Catholic Church bishop, who began to write on eschatology that the belief in a spiritual millennial kingdom took hold. The Roman Catholic Church, the Eastern Orthodox

Churches, and most of the Reformed Protestant denominations teach that doctrine (Anglicans, Calvinists, Lutherans, Presbyterians and a host of other denominations).

We reject this doctrine because it denies the literal fulfilment of Bible prophecy. It is inconceivable that God would fulfil all the prophecies of Christ's first coming in a literal manner, and then have most of the prophecies of His second coming fulfilled in an allegorical manner. As we know from Scripture, *"Jesus Christ is the same yesterday, today, and forever (Hebrews 13:8)."* One must ask who is more trustworthy concerning doctrine: the false Roman Papal Church, which invented Amillennialism, or the Holy Spirit, the apostles and the early church fathers? The Reformed churches merely held on to that doctrine of Amillennialism when they split from the Roman Papal Church just as they did with other false doctrines such as infant baptism and confirmation.

Let's just briefly examine some of these false Amillennial doctrines regarding prophecy:

- False teachings that Christ Jesus came back in A.D. 70 (even though no one saw Him or recorded it).
- False teachings that all prophecy has been fulfilled in A.D. 70.
- False teachings saying that there is no future for Israel; the church has replaced Israel.
- Their erroneous belief that there is no reign of Christ on earth called the Millennium even though the book of Revelation specifically tells us in chapter 20 that there is.

Chapter 20 specifically mentions the Millennium six times in the first four verses. Even the apostles acknowledged Christ's kingdom on earth in the book of Acts. After being with Jesus for 40 days after His resurrection and learning about things pertaining to the future kingdom of God these apostles came together and asked Jesus, *"Lord, will You at this time restore the kingdom to Israel (1:3-6)."* Their question revealed that they still expected Christ to set up His literal earthly kingdom immediately. The Lord did not rebuke them or correct them for expecting His literal reign on earth. He simply told them they could not know when His kingdom would come. He said, *"It is not for you to know the times...."*

Today, looking back with hindsight, we can see that the kingdom of God spoken of by the apostles was not to come for another 2000 years until the end times. After the Six-Day War in 1967 when the Jewish people regained control of Jerusalem after 2500 years, fulfilling Christ's prophecy, the only two future events preceding the kingdom of God is the **Rapture** and the **Tribulation** period. With the Jewish people back in their homeland, all prophecy to date has been fulfilled and the next great event on God's prophetic calendar is the Rapture when Christ's body of believers worldwide, the Church, is taken up to heaven to be with the Lord.

You may not want to hear this, but the majority of churches in North America have already gone apostate, and that is the truth. Those churches that are not dead are slowly dying. Fact is people aren't going to church; they can see the hypocrisy that goes on in these churches. The numbers attending churches have fallen drastically since the 1950s and 1960s. Simple fact is that the gospel is not preached in many of these churches. They don't know about the end times, they don't talk about the hard things, because they desperately want to make people feel comfortable. They want to entertain people; make them happy so that they will come back week after week and drop their money into the offering plate. People aren't stupid; they can see what's going on. Simple fact is that we have dead churches that are stuffed to the gills with dead ministers, and the people are not getting told the truth about the great shaking events of the end times that are coming. We have to wake up as children of God and warn others about what is coming. Very painful economic times are coming and we diligently need to prepare ourselves and warn others to bear up against the coming storms.

[I have detailed in my book *Don't Be Deceived*, many chapters dealing with Amillennialism and other false theological doctrines that are pervasive in our churches today. Please request my book to find out more as I don't have time to go into it here].

In my opinion, we have been warned about the coming economic collapse in a multitude of different ways but most importantly by prophecy written 2000 to 3000 years ago. Again, from a biblical perspective, at this point; what is coming should be glaringly obvious to everyone who read and follow Scripture. In my previous chapter I discussed in detail some of those gathering financial storm clouds and

show you that a horrific economic collapse is coming. My goal is never to create fear. Rather, my goal is to wake people up and give them hope. Yes, very, very painful economic times are coming and it will be hard on everyone. Those that heed the warning and diligently prepare will have a good chance of weathering the coming storm. I honestly don't know what those who have made absolutely no preparations are going to do.

Timewise, my main concern is for the next 16 or so years before the Rapture when God's body of believers, the Church, is taken up to heaven. After that the Tribulation period begins; then there is not very much anyone can do as God's wrath (His anger) is poured upon the unbelieving inhabitants of the earth. It will be a time of unimaginable suffering upon the face of the earth as never before experienced in the history of mankind. God describes this period of time as people wanting to die to escape the intense suffering but they won't be able to. This is what God says: *"In those days men will seek death and will not find it; they will desire to die, and death will flee from them (Rev. 9:6)."* During the Tribulation the Antichrist will come up onto the world stage promising to be Mr. fix-it for the world's problems and people will follow him and he will be the end time world ruler. You will not be able to buy or sell or do any type of commerce without his authority (mark of the beast). He will demand you give him total allegiance and worship. If you resist, you won't be able to hide; you will be eliminated. The choice will be clear; you either worship him or worship God and pay with your life.

Throughout biblical history God has used His prophets to warn His people of the coming impending disasters or hardships. Here in the book of Revelation we see God warning us about the end days of man's government on earth and the enduring hardships that are coming upon this generation of the end times. The book of Revelation reveals the horrific end time events of the Tribulation period. Those of us who are believers in Christ will not be here on earth but we will be watching from heaven the unfolding disaster happening on earth during the Tribulation period. Now, you need to understand that there will be economic hardships along the way leading up to the Tribulation. After all this is one of my main reasons for writing this book; to inform and warn individuals about God's prophetic plans for the end times so we can prepare for what's coming. After all, you don't prepare when the storm hits, rather you prepare when the storm is still off in the distance.

Throughout the scriptures those that prepare are commended. For example just check out the parable of the "Ten Virgins" in Matthew 25. Do you want to be like the wise virgins or the foolish virgins?

I really had to think hard about this; about offering advice and how we might go about preparing ourselves for the coming economic disaster. The reality is that getting prepared is going to look different for each family based on their own unique circumstances. Some people have a lot of resources, while others have very little. Some people are very independent of the system and can move wherever they want, while others are totally dependent on their jobs or have health issues and must stay in the large cities at least for now. As I've written in my previous chapter, our economic collapse is not going to happen all at once and there will also be a reset of the financial system down the road. This worldwide economic meltdown is going to unfold over the next 16 years or so.

What can we do to prepare ourselves? Originally, I sat down and listed 21 things to help prepare ourselves but then I got to thinking about how everyone's situation and circumstances will be different and how hard it is to give advice when we ourselves don't know exactly where and when these financial storms are going to hit us. Instead, I have put together some basic, simple, common sense things we can all do to prepare ourselves for the hard economic times coming.

After seeing what I've written, you will understand, and you can apply your own thoughts and ideas in regards to your own situation and what you can do to prepare yourself and your family. The storm clouds are gathering and I have no doubt about what's coming and I think you will be thankful for the time and effort that you spend getting yourself prepared. Here are some basic, common sense ideas for our generation and our children:

- **Stay out of debt.** You do not want to be a slave to debt when the next wave of the economic collapse strikes. It is definitely not a time to acquire more debt. If you have the chance, pay off those pesky credit cards and tighten up the family budget. The key to insulating yourself from an economic crisis is to become as independent as possible, and as long as you're in debt, you simply are not independent.

- **You need to reduce your expenses and live within your means.** We all spend money on things that we do not really need so eliminate unnecessary future purchases (you'll know what they are). Those that are "lean and mean" will tend to do much better during the hard times that are coming. What you can control is your household economics.
- **Try to have two months worth of cash on hand.** If there is an extended bank holiday because of a banking crisis that causes the ATM machines to go down, you want to be able to have enough cash to buy the things that your family needs. If capital controls are put in place you may be able to withdraw only so much money at a time. It is also imperative that you have an emergency fund. It should be enough to cover all of your expenses for at least two months. It is unlikely that this global currency or economic reset will be instantaneous. There will exist a period of extreme chaos and uncertainty about the level of economic and financial suffering that will take place. This is why it's a good idea to have enough cash on hand as you don't know how severe it's going to be where you live. Also, having some cash means that if some major crisis should ever befall the banking system, then you'll at least have enough emergency savings that's not at risk.
- **If you're investing in the stock market stay away from bonds.** With interest rates rising these bonds are going to be worth less and less.
- **Avoid counter party risk.** If you have an online brokerage account, you may be surprised to know that you don't actually own a single stock in your portfolio. When you log into your account and buy, say, Apple shares, the brokerage will typically register those shares in its own name, not your name. The shares are effectively owned by your broker. It's their asset not yours. Now ordinarily, this isn't a problem. When the system is functioning normally, institutional counterparty risk is low. But counterparty risk becomes a big deal, and quickly, when the system stops functioning normally. We saw the effects of this during the 2008 financial crisis. As one bank went down, it dragged multiple others with it. It's the same when you deposit your money in a bank. It's no longer your money. It's the

bank's. This is how the system works; your money keeps getting passed around various counterparties. No one ever thinks about counterparty risk until it becomes a problem and then it's too late. The simple way to reduce this risk is to reduce the number of counterparties. Keeping some physical cash on hand in case of an emergency ensures that there is no more middlemen (counterparties) standing between you, and at least a portion of your savings.

- **Bartering items is a must.** You should consider items that you can barter with should paper money not be accepted. Basically that could be anything that people need to live on. Again, don't get carried away with this. If you have too much stuff on hand you become a target for someone to come and take it away. All over the globe, the central banks of the world are recklessly printing money and it doesn't take a genius to know it's going to end very badly. In time of economic crisis precious metals, diamonds and other tangible items do very well because it is real money for exchange or bartering whereas the fiat currencies (paper money) of the world will not hold their value or people won't accept it in exchange for goods. Someday you will be glad that you invested in some gold or silver coins to help you through these hard times. But, don't get carried away with any one item as any thing can be used such as liquor, even if you don't drink. Strange as this might sound it can be used for trade or barter with those that do drink. Hundreds of items can be used for trade or barter just decide what best fits your situation.
- **Move away from the big cities if possible.** For many people, this is simply not possible as it is with me and my wife's health condition. But if you are able, now's a good time to do the move. When the next number of major economic downturn strikes, there could be a lot of social unrest and a dramatic rise in crime in the major cities. If you're able to move to a more rural area you will be in much better shape. If you are in a city, you need to network with people in your own neighbourhood that are trustworthy.
- **Good idea to store some non-perishable supplies.** In a crisis there could be disruption in the food supply due to a number of

reasons. For instance, if there is a truckers strike there will be lack of transportation where trucks can't go to refill supermarket shelves due to an economic crisis. Remember that food stores can be cleared out within 48 hours if panic sets in. Our society is so fragile, so dependent on the interworking of things to provide us with the goods and services that any major disruption can disturb or stop the supply chain of food or any other service. At minimum two to three weeks of non-perishable supplies would be a good idea. Thank God we have such a wide variety of quality canned goods available to us such as salmon, ham, vegetables, beans, cereals, grains etc. Also remember when store shelves are low, prices for food or goods will shoot up.

- **Learn to grow some of your own food.** This is a skill that most of our parents possessed in the past. Growing your own food and canning it is a way to become more independent of the system, and it is a way to get prepared for what is ahead. Even if you don't have acreage most city lots would provide you space to have a garden to grow vegetables, etc.
- **Nobody can survive without water.** It is imperative that you have a plan to provide clean drinking water for your family when disaster strikes. Make sure that you're not caught without a decent source of water in the years ahead. Five drops of laundry bleach per gallon will purify water in a few hours.
- **Have a plan for when the grid goes down.** What would you do if the grid went down and you suddenly did not have power for an extended period of time? You need to have a plan for how you are going to provide power to your home that is independent of the power company.
- **Store medicine, medical and personal hygiene supplies.** You definitely would not want to be without bandages and a first-aid kit. You also do not want to run out of any medications that are crucial for your health. Also, personal hygiene items that you would greatly miss if you did not have them stored up. Painkillers, cold medicine, vitamins, and other health, skin, eye and oral care products you would want to have on hand.

- **Community – develop stronger relationships.** One of the most important assets in any crisis situation is community. If you have friends or neighbours that you can depend upon when times get hard, that is invaluable. The time spent building those bonds now will pay off greatly during a major crisis. In most crisis, people survive through their knowledge, wits, and by helping each other out. You also need to remember that unexpected times brings out the best and worst in people and you need to prepare for this possibility. (Don't put all your eggs in one basket)
- **Get educated and learn some skills.** When things are rapidly changing it is imperative to get educated and stay informed so that you will know what to do. The best physical preparation anyone can make for the coming hard times is to have an indispensable skill that others need. Basic skills like being a handyman fixing things, foraging, hunting and farming will do well. Of course, not everyone can acquire such skills, but if you have the opportunity to learn one, then do so. I can see tradesmen and handymen being in great demand.
- **Have a backup plan and be flexible.** No plan ever unfolds perfectly. When your plan is disrupted, what will you do? The times ahead are going to require us all to be very flexible, and it is those who are willing to adapt that will do the best when things get tough. Remain calm and maintain a positive state of mind.
- **What can we learn from our parents?** During the hard times of the 30's and 40's my parents had to be independent and self-sufficient to survive and provide for us. I remember growing up on the farm, we didn't have money but none of us kids went without food. I remember my parents going to town once or twice a month to buy basic things like flour, sugar, kerosene, canning and other things from the store which the farm didn't provide. The farm provided mom with a huge garden to grow her own vegetables and berries which she would can and provide us with food over the winter. We had cows that provided us with milk, cream and butter and we had livestock, sheep and pigs that provided us with meat. Also chickens, turkeys, ducks and geese provided us with eggs, meat and

feathers that mom used to make down comforters. Talk about recycling; nothing much was thrown away. Even the slops were mixed with grain and given to the pigs. In those days we were totally off the grid never having to rely on electricity. We used kerosene lamps for light and burned mostly wood in the stoves except at night we would use slow burning coal to last over the evening. Talk about being self-sufficient! Now things have changed and very few of us live on farms but those that do and have the ability to be self-sufficient will be the fortunate ones to weather the coming economic crisis.

- **Invest in what is permanent and eternal.** The most important preparation you can make is putting your faith and trust in Christ Jesus. Pray and ask for His guidance in your efforts to prepare for whatever calamity the future holds. God knows what is coming and what you need and He will guide and assist you if you trust in Him. That's the very best advice I could give you.

My intention is not to scare you but it is important that you understand that the economic landscape has totally changed. In the next 16 or so years before the Rapture, things will be completely unlike what we have ever experienced before in our generation. How will this unraveling economy affect each one of us? The decisions and preparations you make are crucial. The world is in an economic crisis and there are no easy fixes to our predicament. Remember the Boy Scouts motto: Be Prepared! With biblical insight and grounded reasoning we can face the coming disruptions without fearing the future or panicking when we know *WHO* holds our future. My desire would be that you would come to your senses when you see these financial storm clouds gathering and that you would put your faith and trust in Christ Jesus and ask Him to come into your heart to be your Lord and Saviour while there is still time. I can't comprehend why anyone would, after seeing the signs of our times, knowingly want to experience God's wrath on earth and go into the Tribulation period; putting their eternal life in jeopardy.

Still sceptical! You only have to look at the latest news coming out of Greece to see what is happening right now and this is only going to spread as most of Europe is a basket case. What is happening in Europe is just a precursor of what will eventually be coming to our continent.

When the political and economic systems of entire nations like Greece collapse the consequences are devastating. A collapse in the country's economy has forced many Greeks to turn to black-market barter economies and have left millions financially devastated, with no hope of finding an income stream for the foreseeable future. The credit system of the entire country is in shambles and reports are emerging about food shortages and hunger within the Greek prison systems, suggesting that serious problems in the food delivery chain have begun to materialize. We are now beginning to see the rise of extreme political parties globally as a consequence of the total and utter desperation of the populace. Prepare to live in perilous times before the Rapture occurs.

This isn't meant to scare you. It is just important that you understand that the economic landscape has totally changed and it is unlike anything we have ever experienced before in our lifetime. Most people can't fathom that a major change or shift is coming and they will continue to go about their lives as if nothing is unusual or out of the ordinary. Sadly, most people still have blind faith that world leaders actually know what they are doing and will be able to fix things. And of course the mainstream media does all it can to reinforce faith in the system. Please get prepared while you still can. Please don't be complacent as a great storm is coming, and time is running out.

Keep your head in the game and your hope in God

Our financial security can vanish very quickly. All of us are sure to be affected in some way. Some of us may have already felt the pinch. We cannot escape what is happening in the world. As I have discussed in this chapter, we are now seeing the looming shadow being cast by biblically predicted events, and we cannot avoid living under that shadow. We may experience difficulties due to the global economic and political disintegration, but if we know that we are in God's hands we can trust Him for our future well-being. Even though the world may be spinning out of control, we have good reason to hope. We have a heavenly home that awaits us.

We live in a world where everything is temporary; temporary pleasure, temporary satisfaction, and temporary fulfilment. There is only one thing in your home that is not temporary. There is only one thing that you can take with you into the next world (eternity). When you get to

the end of your life and take in your last breath; what do you want your life to have been about?

No earthly commodity is going to make it from this world into the next. Not land, homes, bank accounts, titles nor achievements – *ONLY SOULS*. My dear friends, Jesus Christ taught that every human being's soul/spirit would be resurrected to spend an eternity in community with God in heaven or in isolation separated from God in a place He reserved for His adversary; Satan.

I don't know what the final assessment of my earthly life will be once I'm gone. But I know this much: The best thing that's ever happened in my life, I want to share with others and my heartfelt desire while I am still around is to share God's love and the good news of Christ Jesus and to present the gospel message to you. Now, it's up to you as to what you do with the gospel message and the choices you make. What more can I do! Speaking the truth in love can never be wrong.

As I have shown you in this book, we are living in very fragile times. The truth is, these are unprecedented times. We are charting new territory almost every day. I hope this book has opened up your eyes to a few things about the future and the end times and the national and international economy that you may not have been aware of. You and I can do nothing about the problems we see in the world economic order. We cannot control world economics, but we can do much to control our own destiny and where we will spend eternity.

Finally, after everything is said and done the only one thing that really matters is where you're going to spend eternity. That choice is available to you while you're still alive to make that decision; to accept or reject Christ Jesus and what He did for you on Calvary's cross nearly 2000 years ago. It's all of Him and none of us or what we can do; we can only cling to His righteousness. Simply, you can't earn your salvation by trying to be good, trying to keep the commandments, going to church or any one of the other hundred things you can think of doing. No! Scripture clearly tells us that salvation is by grace.... through faith. *"For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God, not of works, lest anyone should boast (Ephesians 2:8-9)."* Salvation is simply a free gift from God; thanks to His grace. Like any other gift you receive, you can either accept it or reject it; those are our options. Choose wisely as each and every one of

us will spend eternity in either one or two places according to Scripture. At man's death, Ecclesiastics 12:7 says, *"Then the dust will return to the earth (this is our physical body) and the spirit or the living soul returns to God that gave it."* Every human being is on a journey to eternity. God created us to have fellowship with Him for all eternity; it was not a temporary relationship.

Let me explain: In Genesis 2:7 it says, *"And the Lord God formed man of the dust of the ground, and breathed into his nostrils the breath of life; and man became a living soul."* God made man a perfect being from the dust of the ground but man did not become "alive" until the breath of "life" or God's Spirit was breathed into him. Then man became a living soul. It was the breath of life that allowed man to live. This breath of life is also called the Spirit of God and it is also referred to by many people as the **living soul**. It is the spirit or soul that makes man distinct from the animal world and makes man unique among all of God's creation (see 1 Thess.5:23). With God's spirit, man became God-conscious and that allows man to know, understand and have communion with God.

This is confirmed and referenced in Job 32:8, *"But there is a spirit in man, And the breath of the Almighty gives him understanding."* The definition of God's being is clearly expressed in John 4:24 where it says, *"God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."* God is not a mere physical being, subject to all the errors and limitations of humanity. Neither is He confined to any one place at any time. He is an invisible Person (spirit) who is present in all places at one and the same time, who is all-knowing, and who is all-powerful. He is perfect in all His ways. Therefore, those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth. There must be no sham or hypocrisy. There must be no pretense to being religious, when inwardly one's life is corrupt.

God's great desire was to have communion and fellowship with man, so He created man and placed him in a material world. For man to communicate and have a tangible relationship with the physical world, God created man with a physical body capable of such communication. However, because God is "spirit," man was able to communicate with God in spirit because at creation God placed His spirit within man's body. Man, now a "living soul," stood between two worlds and

belonged to both. Through his physical body, man was linked to the visible, material, and earthly world around him and through his spirit he was linked to the spiritual, eternal, and heavenly world of God Himself.

Your eternal salvation is the most important thing in this life. It doesn't matter what you've accomplished if you lose your "living soul" – you lose it all. You are dead to God and separated from Him for all eternity. There is nothing in this world that is worth losing your soul for. Your soul is worth more than the whole world and everything in it. Your soul is the part of you that is going to live on forever and ever throughout eternity; either being with your Creator forever or being separated from Him for all eternity in a place He reserved for Satan and his fallen angels. Sadly, the vast majority of people are living their lives as though they don't believe there is going to be an eternity. Most people think that our physical death is the end of everything when actually it's the beginning of our eternal destiny. Life is all about choices!
